Mashpee River

- Headwaters, Mashpee Pond
- Ends in Popponesset Bay
- Historically significant trout stream, visited by Daniel Webster, site of John Farley's Fishing Club that rented fishing rights and employed native guides.
- Herring run with ladder at Rte. 130
- Lower portion of river is tidal to above Rte. 28
- Significant amount of river tangent lands in conservation with many riparian walking trails and scenic vistas.
- Currently suffers from nutrient over-enrichment, but still remains an excellent kayaking/canoeing locale with abundant wildlife and scenic views.
- Launching available at Mashpee Neck Rd. ramp
- Bordered in many areas by fallow and mostly overgrown bogs
- Aquaculture activity in lower estuarine section
